# About Asian University Presidents Forum (AUPF)


# History

The Asian University Presidents Forum originated from a friendly collaboration beginning in December 1999 between institutions of higher learning in China and Thailand. In order to establish a mechanism through which university presidents from China and Thailand could frequently exchange information and management experience, Guangdong University of Foreign Studies, Chaoshan College, Srinakharinwirot University and Siamese University of Thailand jointly put forward a proposal to establish a conference for Sino-Thai higher education institutions. The proposed conference was to be held annually and would seek expansion to include university presidents throughout Asia.



# Year Wise Organizer 2002-2019









































# Member Universities:


